1

Biofencing

lining of trees at the boundaries of a site to serve as windbreaks, enriching the soil, controlling dust and providing shades.

2

Softscaping (Gardens) and Hardscaping

designing some specific and strategic points with ornamental plants (trees, shrubs, lianas and grasses) within the center to create a beautiful and functional space.

3

Lawn Design

The lawn is an area where grass is grown as a green carpet for a landscape and is the basic feature of any garden. It serves to enhance the beauty of the garden, be it larger or smaller.
